

2019 - 2020 SLSSC Fee Schedule

To help families and the club manage costs, **Regular Season (Group) Fees** are broken into **3 components**:

- 1. Registration Fee** - payable upon registration
- 2. Fundraising Fee** - a cheque post-dated to March 31, 2020 is collected and families have the option to work off this amount by participating in fundraising programs offered by the club
- 3. Volunteering Fee** - a cheque post-dated to March 31, 2020 is collected and families have the option to work off this amount by volunteering throughout the skating year; **1 unit is approximately 8 hours**

Where families have more than one child in the club, Fundraising and Volunteering are 100% for the eldest skater and 50% for additional, younger skaters in the family; see "Second+ Skater" lines.

Registration Fees include SASSA and SSC Memberships where applicable. In addition, **at least one parent must purchase an Associate Membership in the club.**

Per skater	\$85	This program is designed to jump-start the beginner skater, ages 4 years and older . Skaters wear their own hockey or figure skates. Credit is given toward regular season group sessions if skaters continue: 100% for Full Season 2 Days per week, 50% for Full Season 1 Day or Half Season 2 Days per week, 25% for Half Season 1 Day per week. Associate Membership is not required to be purchased for families participating in Short Learn to Skate Membership in SASSA and SSC is not required.

Skaters are placed in Groups according to skill level and experience:

Group 1 - Learn to Skate: Skaters are at a beginner level and learn basic skating skills on hockey or figure skates.

Group 2 - Learn to Speed Skate: Skaters can competently skate forwards, backwards, stop and crossover. Skaters transition to speed skates.

Group 3 - Learn to Compete: Skaters graduated from Group 2 as well as competent skaters from other disciplines who want to give speed skating a try.

Group 4 - Advanced Competitive: Skaters competing at a higher level, with many competing on a national level.
